What struck me was the size of these trees. They were huge yet many had come crashing down. The kids were able to climb on to the trunks and balance walking down them and we were all able to hide under the roots that had become visible. It got me thinking...Without a relationship with God through Jesus Christ, our lives are always in danger of becoming like such trees.

You see some of us have no doubt matured, maybe into great 'Oak tree's' whether it be through age or spiritual maturity. However, whether that is the case or not, if our roots do not continue to go deep into the right places, we become weaker without knowing it and when storms come, we are in danger of crashing down so to speak.

Jesus speaks about something similar when he taught the parable of the wise and foolish builders. The wise man, Jesus says, is the man who builds his house on rock. The foolish man builds his house on sand. Jesus was saying this: when a person builds their life on Jesus' words, such as listening to them and putting them into practice, they are wise because they are building strong foundations for the future. He or she will be strong on the inside no matter what happens on the outside. No matter what storm of life comes their way.

The foolish person is someone who listened to Jesus' instructions but then ignores them. Such a person may seem strong on the outside but will be weak on the inside and the danger is all too obvious.
